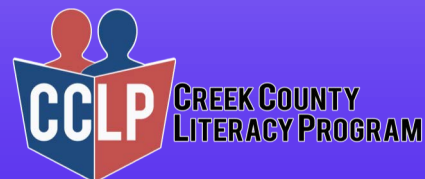

The Spelling Bee is a fun-filled event designed to promote awareness about literacy and to raise funds in support of Creek County Literacy Program.

Teams of three members compete by correctly spelling words, advancing to the Ultimate Stinger Round.

If your company can't send a team of three, CCLP will recruit a team from a local school or 501(c)(3) non-profit organization to represent your organization. Absolutely no effort is required on your part, and your donation will still help support the fight against low literacy and illiteracy.



Funds raised will be used to provide learning materials, resources and support for adults and children in our community working to improve their basic reading and writing skills.

Trophies will be awarded for Best Team Name, Best Theme Costumes, Best Team Spirit and Best Spellers will be presented at the end of the evening.

Mulligans may be purchased for \$20. Limit two Mulligans per team.

THE BUZZ ...

Each team consists of **three members**. Once the judge announces the word, Teams are given **30 seconds** to confer and spell the word. The team writes the word on the marker board and gives the board to the Monitor. **One point** for each correct letter is awarded. Once a wrong letter is written, the rest of the letters of the word do not count for points. After an allotted number of words are given, points are tallied and the top three teams advance to the traditional "Ultimate Stinger Round".

It's never too late to learn! Creek County Literacy Program's primary emphasis is on **youth and adult literacy.**

Adults interested in improving their basic reading and writing skills are matched with trained volunteer tutors from the community. Pairs work towards the adult learner's goals which may range from getting a better job to being able to read a bedtime story to his/her child.

It's never too early to learn! The **Caring Grands Reading Program** provides senior citizen volunteers to tutor first and second grade struggling readers at 12 of 17 Creek County elementary schools. Students are gifted a book each week, building their personal home library.

Programs include:

- **Adult Literacy** One-on-one reading, writing, spelling and math instruction
- **Youth Literacy** After school tutoring for youth
